## Introduction

You and your pupils are sitting in a circle on the ground; all the picture cards are in the middle of the circle.

Now you can ask:

- "What can you see on the pictures?"

After the children have answered, you might say:

- "Yes. Right. There is a lot of food."
- "What do you like best?"
- "Anna, do you like sausages?" (pick up the card)
- "Who else likes sausages?"
- "Who likes spaghetti?"
- ......
- "I like pizza, steak and ice cream. But my favourite food is ice cream!"
- (to Jimmy) "Jimmy, what is your favourite food?"
- Jimmy:" Oh, my favourite food is chocolate pudding!"
- "What is 'favourite food' in German?"
- (to the children) "What is your favourite food?"
o children say what their favourite food is

Tell the children a story of Jimmy, using the picture cards at the right place. Support the understanding of the story with gestures (e.g. my tummy is rumbling)

## Jimmy's journey to the restaurant

Jimmy comes home from school. He is very hungry. His mum and dad are on holiday. That's why his aunt is living at Jimmy's house.
She opens the door: "Hi Jimmy. How are you?"
Jimmy answers: "Hi auntie. I'm fine. But l'm so hungry. I'm so hungry, but I don't know what to eat."

His aunt laughs: "Jimmy, do you know what? My tummy is rumbling, too. And we don't have enough food at home. Let's go to the restaurant."
Jimmy is happy. "Oh, yes. Let's go!"

So an hour later they are sitting in the restaurant and look into the menu card. (You should draw a big sized menu card all over the black board, where you can put the picture cards now to the right place 'main dish', ‘side dish', 'dessert', 'drinks')

Then the waiter comes to them and says: "Good afternoon! What would you like to drink?" Jimmy orders first: "I'd like to drink lemonade! I love lemonade!"
His aunt follows: "You drink lemonade and l'd like a glass of orange juice!"
The waiter nods: "Okay and what would you like to eat?"
This time his aunt orders first: "I'd like to eat fish with potatoes and beans."
Jimmy says: "Hm, I don't know yet. But ... yes, I'll have pizza."
The waiter writes down the order.
Jimmy is excited: "Auntie, auntie, I would also like to eat a dessert. May I?"
His aunt answers: "Yes, Jimmy, you can have a dessert. But afterwards, let's eat the main and side dish first."

The waiter laughs: "So, what would you like for dessert? We have chocolate pudding, icecream and fruit salad."

Jimmy smiles and says: "I'd like chocolate pudding for dessert! And now l'm really hungry!"
